2. **Poster—Research:** Poster should describe a scholarly educational intervention that include preliminary or final outcomes

3. **Oral presentation—Innovations in medical education.** This is an oral presentation of non-research oriented innovation aimed at sharing new or creative approaches to teaching, learning, evaluation, curriculum management, or student affairs.
